Typical Monthly Cost of Child Care

Child Care Subsidies

Working Connections Child Care helps low-income families pay for child care while the adults are working, looking for work or in an approved training program. The program is funded by state and federal funds and administered by the Washington State Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS). Federal Child Tax Credit

If you have a child under 17 and owe federal income taxes, the Child Tax Credit may help you pay a portion of your taxes. If you qualify for an Additional Child Tax Credit, you do not have to owe taxes to be able to receive a credit.
